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## Liquid Nitrogen Therapy Post Treatment Care

- In a few hours or days, an ulcer, a crust, or a blister will develop at the treated site. If the blister has a bloody content, do not panic. This is normal.
- If there is a blister, release the contents with a sterile needle. After opening the blister, clean the area with normal saline solution and apply Polysporin, Bacitracin or Bactroban on the area. **Do not apply Neosporin or Triple Antibiotic.** Apply a band-aid and change it daily.
- If there is a crust, cleanse the area with soap and water or normal saline solution and apply Polysporin, Bacitracin or Bactroban on the area. **Do not apply Neosporin.** Apply a band-aid.
- Do not remove the crust. It will increase the risk of scarring.
